OLD FOLKS NEWS

I have made some RULE CHANGES in regards to the PONDS on the BACK 9:

If you play from WHITE tees: if tee ball lands in pond, penalty one stroke and re-tee from WHITE tees.

If you play from GOLD tee on #13: if tee ball lands in water, penalty one stroke and re-tee from GOLD tee.

If you play from GOLD tee on #17: DO NOT use the GOLD tee, tee-off from the LOWER or RED tee, skip the GOLD.

The pond immediately in front of and along the sides of the 17th green: if your APPROACH shot lands in the water, go to the new OLD FOLKS "drop zone" at end of pond on left, take a one shot penalty and chip onto the green. An "APPROACH" shot is defined as any shot NOT played from a tee box. Any comments?
